

## How to Make Adobe Acrobat Reader Available in Safari


- Open Safari
- Click on Safari in the menu bar at the top of the screen
- Click on preferences
- Click on Security tab at the top
- Make sure there is a check in the Internet plug-ins box



 Click on the Website Settings pull down menu across from the plugins check



- Click on Adobe Reader on the left hand side of the pop up box to add the plug-in
- Click "allow" on the pull down on the right
