

Maricopa County - Cave Creek Landfill Remediation Project

Weekly Update for week ending 6/6/2022

Below is a summary of activity that took place for the Cave Creek Landfill project last week.

NOTE: The Weekly Update now includes a look ahead at the activities planned in the next two weeks at the Phase 3 (Injection Well) site on Sleepy Ranch Road. Activities are subject to change.

Phase 3 GWTS (Injection Well and Infrastructure)

- Hunter began backfilling the wastewater reservoir following successful hydrostatic testing.
- Hunter continued excavating for the electrical gear pad.
- Wood submitted a supplemental technical appeal to the City of Phoenix requesting amendment
 of an existing sewer easement to allow installation of the APS electrical line within the
 easement.
- Upcoming work in the next 2 weeks includes:
 - o Install rebar and forms for the electrical gear pad.
 - o Place duct bank for the electrical gear pad and pour pad.
 - o Excavate for injection well vault.
 - Cut injection well casing down prior to vault placement.
 - o Fine grade and place rebar and forms for injection well vault slab.
 - o Set well vault and connect exterior piping to vault.
 - o Excavate, place forms and rebar for the filter skid pad.

SVE Operations (Source Remediation)

The soil vapor extraction (SVE) system operated throughout the period.

Drilling Operations

No drilling related work took place during the period.

Communications

- Wood provided Maricopa County and ADEQ with a project update via email on 05/31/2022.
- Wood notified ADEQ via phone call on 06/01/2022 of the need to delay drilling of groundwater monitoring well MW-14 due to lack of drill rig availability.

Sampling

• Wood staff continued the 2nd Quarter 2022 Groundwater Monitoring event during the period.
